Fulford Parish Council has not been consulted on this application but at our meeting held on 22nd Jan, the proposals were discussed and it was agreed to write to you.

Under the EIA Regulations 2011, the approval of details under a condition is classed as a 'subsequent application' in respect of EIA development. The application therefore requires publicity and full consultation as described in the Regulations. The Council must take the responses (including responses from the public and statutory consultees) and other environmental information into account before the application can be lawfully determined.

We do not at this time provide comment on the submitted information, but will do so through the consultation process, which we trust the Council will now undertake.
