# Germany Beck Project

## Weeks 18 & 19 commencing 10th October

During the past 2 weeks we have been importing stone to create the carriageway embankments to the east and west of Fordlands Road.

We have also been carrying out welding to the recently installed sheet piled walls.

The installation of drainage has commenced to the east of Fordlands Road.



During the next two weeks we will continue to import stone into site off Fordlands Road and progress the drainage installation.

We do not anticipate any disruption to traffic using the A19 or Fordlands Road or footpath closures in the next few weeks but please be aware of stone deliveries using the site entrances off Fordlands Road.

We will be receiving further deliveries of stone to site this week. Each delivery will be guided into site by one of our employees once traffic and pedestrians are clear from the site entrance. Please be patient if you are held up for a short time whilst these manoeuvres take place.

Pedestrians will be given right of way along the footpaths of Fordlands Road but please be aware of deliveries using the entrances to site off Fordlands Road on occasion.
